~~An act to amend Sections 12815 and 13000 of the Vehicle Code, relating to the Department of Motor Vehicles. An act to amend Section 64 of the Harbors and Navigation Code, relating to the Department of Boating and Waterways.~~

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 125, as amended, Leach. ~~Driver's license: identification card~~
Department of Boating and Waterways: Hydrocotyle.

Existing law designates the Department of Boating and Waterways as the lead agency of the state for the purpose of cooperating with agencies of the United States and other public agencies in controlling water hyacinth and Egeria densa in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta, its tributaries, and the Suisun Marsh. Existing law authorizes the department, other state agencies, cities, counties, and districts to cooperate with one another and with agencies of the United States in controlling water hyacinth and Egeria densa in those areas, and to furnish money, services, equipment, and other property to that end.

This bill also would designate the department to be the lead agency in cooperating with other agencies in controlling Hydrocotyle and would authorize the department, other state agencies, cities, counties, and districts to cooperate with one another and with agencies of the United States in controlling Hydrocotyle in the delta, its tributaries, and

the marsh, and to furnish money, services, equipment, and other property to that end.

~~Existing law provides for the replacement of a driver’s license by the Department of Motor Vehicles upon application if, among other things, the original license was lost, destroyed, or mutilated.~~

~~This bill would require the department, if the original license is lost, destroyed, or mutilated, prior to issuing a permanent duplicate driver’s license, to compare all photographs and information on file with the department to the likeness and information obtained from the person requesting the duplicate license.~~

~~Existing law directs the department to issue identification cards to persons attesting to certain information. Existing law provides, if that card is lost, destroyed, mutilated, or a new true full name is acquired, the person may make application for a new card.~~

~~This bill would provide that if an application for a duplicate identification card based on the loss, destruction, or mutilation of a previously issued card is made, that application shall be made in person and the department, prior to the issuance of the duplicate card, shall compare all photographs and information on file with the department, with the likeness and information obtained from the application requesting the duplicate.~~

- 4 64. (a) The Legislature hereby finds and declares that the
- 5 growth of water hyacinth, *Hydrocotyle*, and *Egeria densa* in the
- 6 Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta, its tributaries, and the Suisun
- 7 Marsh has occurred at an unprecedented level and that the resulting
- 8 accumulations of water hyacinth, *Hydrocotyle*, and *Egeria densa*
- 9 obstruct navigation, impair other recreational uses of waterways,
- 10 have the potential for damaging manmade facilities, and may
- 11 threaten the health and stability of fisheries and other ecosystems
- 12 within the delta and marsh. Accordingly, it is necessary that the
- 13 state, in cooperation with agencies of the United States, undertake
- 14 an aggressive program for the effective control of water hyacinth,

12 tributaries, and the marsh and may furnish money, services,
13 equipment, and other property to that end.

14 (d) Up to five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per year of the funds
15 available for expenditure by the Department of Fish and Game to
16 implement this section shall be paid from the Harbors and
17 Watercraft Revolving Fund.

18 (e) Whenever any control program is proposed to take place in
19 Rock Slough, the department and the Contra Costa Water District
20 shall develop a memorandum of understanding establishing the
21 parameters of the control program. This subdivision does not
22 apply to any control program proposed for Sand Mound Slough.

25 ~~destroyed or mutilated, or a new true, full name is acquired, the~~

28 ~~(1) Satisfactory proof of that loss, destruction, or mutilation.~~

29 ~~(2) If the licensee is a minor, evidence of permission to obtain~~

32 ~~(b) If the original license is lost, destroyed, or mutilated, the~~

3 ~~agency that the document is mutilated shall surrender the license~~
4 ~~to the department not later than 10 days after that notification.~~

5 ~~(e) For purposes of this section, a mutilated license is one that~~
6 ~~has been damaged sufficiently to render any or all of the elements~~
7 ~~of identity set forth in Sections 12800.5 and 12811 unreadable or~~
8 ~~unidentifiable through visual, mechanical, or electronic means.~~
