An act to add Sections 25402.6 and 25402.7 to the Public Resources Code, relating to energy resources, and making an appropriation therefor.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 549, as amended, Longville. California Energy Commission: building standards.

(1) Existing law requires the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission to prescribe, by regulation, various energy efficiency design standards for residential and nonresidential buildings.

This bill would require the commission to investigate options and develop a plan to decrease wasteful peak load energy consumption in existing residential and nonresidential buildings. The bill would require the commission to report its findings, on or before January 1, 2003, to the Legislature.

This bill would require electric and gas utilities to provide support for building standards in consultation with the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission.

(2) The bill would appropriate \$500,000 from the General Fund to the commission, to be expended for the purposes of the ~~compliance~~ ~~monitoring~~ report required by the bill.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 25402.6 is added to the Public
2 Resources Code, to read:

3 25402.6. The commission shall investigate options and
4 develop a plan to decrease wasteful *peak* load energy consumption
5 in existing residential and nonresidential buildings. On or before
6 January 1, 2003, the commission shall report its findings to the
7 Legislature, including, but not limited to, any changes in law
8 necessary to implement the plan to decrease wasteful peak load
9 energy consumption in existing residential and nonresidential
10 buildings.

11 SEC. 2. Section 25402.7 is added to the Public Resources
12 Code, to read:

13 25402.7. In consultation with the State Energy Resources
14 Conservation and Development Commission, electric and gas
15 utilities shall provide support for building standards and other
16 regulations pursuant to Section 25402 and subdivision (b) of
17 Section 25553 including appropriate research, development, and
18 training to implement those standards and other regulations.

19 SEC. 3. The sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000)
20 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the State Energy
21 Resources Conservation and Development Commission, to be
22 expended for the purposes of Section 25402.6 of the Public
23 Resources Code.
