An act to amend Section 900 of the Government Code, relating to public entity liability.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2321, as introduced, Hertzberg. Tort Claims Act.

The existing Tort Claims Act provides for the liability and immunity of a governmental entity for its acts or omissions that cause harm to persons. Existing law contains definitions for purposes of the interpretation of its provisions.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to that existing law.
