

**Senate Bill No. 766**

**CHAPTER 878**

An act relating to parks and recreation, and making an appropriation therefor.

[Approved by Governor October 13, 2001. Filed with Secretary of State October 14, 2001.]

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 766, Burton. Parks and recreation.

Existing law contains various provisions related to parks and recreation.

This bill would allocate \$190,000,000 of the funds appropriated by the proposed California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002, for urban park and recreation purposes, if Senate Bill 359 and Assembly Bill 1481 of the 2001–02 Regular Session are enacted.

Appropriation: yes.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. If the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002 (Ch. 1.696 (commencing with Sec. 5096.600), Div. 5, P.R.C.) is approved by the voters at the March 5, 2002, primary election, of the funds allocated pursuant to subdivision (d) of Section 5096.620 of the Public Resources Code, one hundred forty million dollars (\$140,000,000) shall be expended for the purposes of Assembly Bill 1481 of the 2001–02 Regular Session, if that bill is enacted, and fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000) shall be expended for the purposes of Senate Bill 359 of the 2001–02 Regular Session, if that bill is enacted.
