SENATE BILL

No. 1935

Introduced by Senator Costa

February 22, 2002

An act to amend Sections 18001.8 and 18012.5 of, *and to add Section 18015.1 to*, the Health and Safety Code, relating to commercial coaches.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1935, as amended, Costa. Commercial coaches: commercial modulars.

The Mobilehomes-Manufactured Housing Act of 1980, authorizes the Department of Housing and Community Development to adopt regulations for the construction of commercial coaches and special purpose commercial coaches. A knowing violation of the act or regulations issued pursuant to it is punishable as a misdemeanor. The act defines a special purpose commercial coach as a vehicle with or without motive power, designed for human occupancy, for industrial, professional, or commercial purposes, that is not required to be moved under a permit.

This bill would ~~extend the applicability of~~ *provide that* the definition of a commercial coach and special purpose commercial coach ~~to a~~ *means the same as* commercial modular and special purpose commercial modular, respectively, *and applies to all statutory references of these terms.*

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 18001.8 of the Health and Safety Code
2 is amended to read:

4 18001.8. “*Commercial modular*” means a structure
5 transportable in one or more sections, designed and equipped for
6 human occupancy for industrial, professional, or commercial
7 purposes, which is required to be moved under permit, and shall
8 include a trailer coach as defined in Section 635 of the Vehicle
9 Code. “*Commercial coach*” has the same meaning as
10 “*commercial modular*” as that term is defined in this section.

11 SEC. 2. Section 18012.5 of the Health and Safety Code is
12 amended to read:

13 ~~18012.5. “Special purpose commercial coach” or “special~~
14 18012.5. “*Special purpose commercial modular*” means a
15 vehicle with or without motive power, designed and equipped for
16 human occupancy for industrial, professional, or commercial
17 purposes, which is not required to be moved under permit, and
18 shall include a trailer coach. “*Special purpose commercial coach*”
19 has the same meaning as “*special purpose commercial modular*”
20 as that term is defined in this section.

21 SEC. 3. Section 18015.1 is added to the Health and Safety
22 Code, to read:

23 18015.1. All statutory references to “*commercial coach*” and
24 to “*special purpose commercial coach*” are hereby deemed to
25 refer to “*commercial modular*” and to “*special purpose*
26 *commercial modular*,” respectively.
