

ASSEMBLY BILL

Introduced by Assembly Member Calderon

February 18, 2003

An act to repeal and add Section 319 of the Streets and Highways Code, relating to streets and highways.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 535, as introduced, Calderon. Highways: Route 19 relinquishment.

Existing law requires the California Transportation Commission to relinquish to any city or county any portion of any state highway within the city or county that has been deleted from the state highway system by legislative enactment. Existing law authorizes the commission to relinquish to the cities of Downey and Bellflower specified portions of State Highway Route 19.

This bill would also authorize the commission to relinquish to the City of Pico Rivera specified portions of State Highway Route 19, upon terms and conditions the commission finds to be in the best interests of the state. The bill would also redefine the portion of Route 19 that the commission may relinquish to the City of Downey.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 319 of the Streets and Highways Code,
- 2 as added by Section 21 of Chapter 597 of the Statutes of 2001, is
- 3 repealed.

1 319.—(a) Route 19 is from Route 1 near Long Beach to Route
2 164 near Pico Rivera.

3 (b) The portion of Route 19 that is between Del Amo Boulevard
4 in the City of Long Beach and Route 1 in that city shall cease to
5 be a state highway pursuant to the terms of a cooperative
6 agreement between the City of Long Beach and the department
7 providing for the relinquishment of that portion of the highway to
8 that city.

9 (c) (1) The commission may relinquish to the City of Downey
10 the portion of Route 19 located between Century Boulevard and
11 Telegraph Road within that city, upon terms and conditions the
12 commission finds to be in the best interests of the state and
13 pursuant to the terms of a cooperative agreement between the City
14 of Downey and the department.

15 (2) A relinquishment under this subdivision shall become
16 effective immediately following the county recorder's recordation
17 of the relinquishment resolution containing the commission's
18 approval of the terms and conditions of the relinquishment.

19 (d) (1) The commission may relinquish to the City of
20 Bellflower the portion of Route 19 located between the southerly
21 city limit of the City of Bellflower near Rose Avenue and Foster
22 Road within that city, upon terms and conditions the commission
23 finds to be in the best interests of the state and pursuant to the terms
24 of a cooperative agreement between that city and the department.

25 (2) A relinquishment under this subdivision shall become
26 effective immediately following the county recorder's recordation
27 of the relinquishment resolution containing the commission's
28 approval of the terms and conditions of the relinquishment.

29 (e) Any portion of Route 19 relinquished pursuant to
30 subdivision (c) or (d) shall cease to be a state highway on the
31 effective date of the relinquishment.

32 (f) This section shall become inoperative on the effective date
33 of the relinquishment described in subdivision (c) or (d);
34 whichever date is later, and as of January 1 following that date is
35 repealed.

36 SEC. 2. Section 319 of the Streets and Highways Code, as
37 amended by Section 22 of Chapter 597 of the Statutes of 2001, is
38 repealed.

18 SEC. 3. Section 319 is added to the Streets and Highways
19 Code, to read:

20 319. (a) Route 19 is from Del Amo Boulevard near Long
21 Beach to Gardendale Street/Foster Road in the cities of Bellflower
22 and Downey, and then, with an interruption of already
23 relinquished route, from Telegraph Road at the Downey City limit
24 to Route 164 (Galatin Road) at the northerly city limit of Pico
25 Rivera.

26 (b) If the commission determines it is in the State's best
27 interests to do so, it may do the following, pursuant to a
28 cooperative agreement between the city and the department:

29 (1) Relinquish to the City of Bellflower the portion of Route 19
30 between the city's southerly city limit near Rose Avenue and
31 Gardendale Street/Foster Road.

32 (2) Relinquish to the City of Downey the portion of Route 19
33 between the city's southerly city limit at Century Boulevard and
34 Gardendale Street.

35 (3) Relinquish to the City of Pico Rivera the portion of Route
36 19 between Telegraph Road and Gallatin Road.

37 (c) A relinquishment under this section shall become effective
38 when the county recorder records the relinquishment resolution
39 containing the commissioner's approval of the relinquishment's
40 terms and conditions.



1 (d) Any portion of Route 19 relinquished pursuant to this
2 section shall cease to be a state highway on the effective date of the
3 relinquishment.

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
