An act to add Section 366.8 to the Public Utilities Code, relating to public utilities.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2499, as introduced, Jerome Horton. Electrical service: reliability.

Existing law, the Public Utilities Act, states that it is the policy of the state and the intent of the Legislature, to reaffirm that each electrical corporation continue to operate its electric distribution grid in its service territory and do so in a safe, reliable, efficient, and cost-effective manner.

This bill would state that it is the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation to ensure that all customers who receive electrical service from a newly created entity are provided with reliable service.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 366.8 is added to the Public Utilities
