LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 304, as introduced, Morrow. Storm water.

Existing law, the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act, requires the State Water Resources Control Board to prepare and submit to the Legislature on May 1 of each year a report that summarizes the enforcement actions undertaken in the previous calendar year regarding the discharge of storm water.

This bill would change the date on which the report is due to June 1 of each year.
