An act to amend ~~Section 13399.39 of the Water Code, relating to water.~~ relating to service stations.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 304, as amended, Morrow. ~~Storm water~~ Service stations.

*Existing law generally regulates service stations, as defined.*

*This bill would state the intent of the Legislature to reorganize, in a nonsubstantive manner, all statutory provisions governing or affecting the impact of service stations, as defined, upon local communities, including, but not limited to, storm water quality management and retail pricing of gasoline.*

~~Existing law, the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act, requires the State Water Resources Control Board to prepare and submit to the Legislature on May 1 of each year a report that summarizes the enforcement actions undertaken in the previous calendar year regarding the discharge of storm water.~~

~~This bill would change the date on which the report is due to June 1 of each year.~~
