LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 888, as introduced, Dunn. Public utilities: electrical restructuring.

Existing law authorizes the Public Utilities Commission to supervise and regulate every public utility in the state, including electrical corporations, subject to provisions restructuring the electrical industry.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature in subsequent legislation, to repeal those provisions restructuring the electrical industry.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.
