

**Introduced by Senator Figueroa**

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An act to ~~amend~~ *repeal* Sections 18602 and 18613 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to the State Athletic Commission.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 247, as amended, Figueroa. State Athletic Commission.

Existing law, the Boxing Act, creates the State Athletic Commission and makes it responsible for licensing and regulating boxing, kickboxing, and martial arts matches. Under existing law, the commission is required to appoint an executive officer who performs specified duties. Existing law makes these provisions inoperative on July 1, 2006, and repeals them on January 1, 2007.

This bill would ~~instead make these provisions inoperative and repealed on unspecified dates~~ *repeal these provisions*.

18 subject to the review required by Division 1.2 (commencing with
