Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 144—Relative to the Border Patrol Officer Neil Wilkie Hepburn Memorial Bridge.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 144, as introduced, Anderson. Border Patrol Officer Neil Wilkie Hepburn Memorial Bridge.

This measure would designate the bridge on State Highway Route 52 that crosses over West Hills Parkway in Santee, California, as the Border Patrol Officer Neil Wilkie Hepburn Memorial Bridge. The measure would also request that the Department of Transportation determine the cost for appropriate signs showing this special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering that cost, erect those signs.

- 3 Officer Neil Wilkie Hepburn Memorial Bridge; now, therefore,

- 6 *thereof concurring*, That the Legislature hereby designates the
- 7 bridge on State Highway Route 52 that crosses over West Hills
- 8 Parkway in Santee, California, as the Border Patrol Officer Neil
- 9 Wilkie Hepburn Memorial Bridge; and be it further

1 *Resolved*, That the Department of Transportation is requested
2 to determine the cost of appropriate signs, consistent with the
3 signing requirements for the state highway system, showing that
4 special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate
5 sources sufficient to cover that cost, to erect those signs; and be it
6 further

7 *Resolved*, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies
8 of this resolution to the Department of Transportation and to the
9 author for appropriate distribution.
