An act to repeal Section 52499.6 of the Education Code, relating to pupil instruction.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 666, as introduced, Karnette. Pupil instruction: home economics and career technical education.

Existing law, to be repealed on January 1, 2008, establishes an incentive grant program for the purpose of improving, expanding, and establishing instructional programs in home economics careers and technology career technical education to improve the academic achievement and career preparation of pupils in those fields. The program is required to be implemented to the extent funds are appropriated for these purposes in the annual Budget Act. The governing board of a school district that operates a home economics careers and technology career technical education program is authorized to apply to the Superintendent of Public Instruction for an incentive grant under the program.

This bill would delete the repeal date, thereby continuing the program indefinitely.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 52499.6 of the Education Code is  
2 repealed.
