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**Introduced by Assembly Member Caballero**

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An act to add Section 20221.5 to Government Code, relating to public employees' retirement.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2202, as introduced, Caballero. Public Employees' Retirement System: employee information.

The Public Employees' Retirement Law provides that public employees become members of the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) upon entry into employment, with specified exceptions. Existing law excludes from membership in PERS part-time employees unless certain requirements are met. Existing law requires state agencies, school employers, and contracting agencies of PERS to provide specified information to the Board of Administration of PERS regarding employees who are members of the system.

This bill would require every state agency, school employer, or contracting agency of PERS to provide information to the board regarding the service and compensation earned by its part-time, seasonal, or temporary employees who do not meet the requirements for mandatory coverage by the system in the same manner as for members.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 20221.5 is added to the Government  
2 Code, to read:  
3 20221.5. Every state agency, school employer, or contracting  
4 agency of the system shall provide information to the board  
5 regarding the service and compensation earned by its part-time,  
6 seasonal, or temporary employees who do not meet the  
7 requirements for mandatory coverage by the system in the same  
8 manner as information is provided for members of the system.

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
