SENATE BILL

No. 377

Introduced by Senator Aanestad

February 21, 2007

An act to amend Section 44831 of, *and to add Section 44265.4 to*, the Education Code, relating to school employees.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 377, as amended, Aanestad. Schools: ~~certificated employees.~~
employees: speech-language pathologists.

(1) Existing law requires the Commission on Teacher Credentialing to issue preliminary and professional clear credentials in speech-language pathology to qualified individuals. Statutory provisions authorize the Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology Board of the Department of Consumer Affairs to issue temporary and permanent speech-language pathology licenses and audiology licenses to individuals meeting specified requirements.

This bill would require the commission to issue a professional clear credential to an individual who holds a permanent speech-language pathology license issued by the board and who has satisfied specified basic skills proficiency requirements.

Existing

(2) Existing law requires governing boards of school districts to employ persons in public school service requiring certification qualifications pursuant to other requirements, except that the governing board or a county office of education is permitted to contract with or employ an individual who holds a license issued by the Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology Board and has earned a

master's degree in communication disorders to provide speech and language services if that individual meets the requirements of a specified criminal background check and has demonstrated basic skills proficiency before employment or execution of the contract.

~~This bill, instead, would permit the governing board of a school district to contract with or employ a person who holds a license issued by the Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology Board, pursuant to specified requirements for obtaining that license, and has met specified criminal background check requirements and would recognize that license as equivalent to a speech-language pathology services credential issued by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, without meeting any other requirements generally required to obtain that credential. A person employed based on that license would be authorized to provide speech-language pathology services only in accordance with the related services provisions for speech-language pathology of the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and the policies of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing for the speech-language pathology services credential with an authorization for performing language, speech, and hearing services. The licensed employee would not be authorized to teach courses that are part of the core curriculum and would be required to complete professional development training related to assessing and serving children with disabilities who are English language learners prior to being considered for permanent employment status. The licensed employee would be required to be included, if he or she chooses, in the same bargaining unit as individuals holding specified credentials who are employed by the same school district. The inclusion of the licensed employees in a bargaining unit would be prohibited from nullifying the provisions of a collective bargaining agreement entered into or signed on or after January 1, 2008.~~

This bill, instead, would authorize the governing board of a school district to contract with or employ that licensed individual without the individual demonstrating basic skills proficiency in a specified manner.
