An act to amend Section 25140 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to hazardous wastes.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 932, as introduced, Ashburn. Hazardous waste: listings.

Existing law requires the Department of Toxic Substances Control to prepare, adopt, and revise a listing of wastes that are determined to be hazardous or extremely hazardous, for regulation pursuant to the Hazardous Waste Control Laws.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to that provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 25140 of the Health and Safety Code is
2 amended to read:
3 25140. The department shall prepare, adopt, and may revise
4 when appropriate, a listing of the wastes ~~which that~~ are determined
5 to be hazardous, and a listing of the wastes ~~which that~~ are
6 determined to be extremely hazardous. When identifying ~~such~~
7 ~~wastes these wastes~~, the department shall consider, but not be
8 limited to, the immediate or persistent toxic effects to ~~man~~ humans

- 1 and wildlife and the resistance *of those wastes* to natural
- 2 degradation or detoxification ~~of the wastes~~.
