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An act to add Section 9025.5 to the Government Code, relating to the Legislature.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1411, as amended, Torrico. Legislature: delayed budget bill passage.

The California Constitution requires the Legislature to pass a Budget Bill by June 15 of each year.

This bill would prohibit, if the Budget Bill is not passed by the Legislature and sent to the Governor by midnight on June 30 of each year, Members of the Legislature from engaging in campaign fundraising activities *from July 1 until August 15 or the date on which the Budget Bill is passed and sent to the Governor, whichever occurs first.*

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

7 (b) For purposes of this section, “Budget Bill” means a bill that  
8 makes appropriations for the support of the government of the
