An act to amend Sections 340, 1000, 1001, and 1202 of the Elections Code, relating to elections.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL’S DIGEST

AB 80, as amended, Fong. Presidential primary: election date.

Existing law provides that the presidential primary election is to be held on the first Tuesday in February of those years in which a national presidential election is to be held.

This bill would change the date of the presidential primary election to the first Tuesday after the first Monday in June of presidential election years and would consolidate the presidential primary election with the statewide direct primary election.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 340 of the Elections Code is amended to

- 3 340. “Presidential primary” is the primary election that is held
- 4 on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in June in any year that

1 is evenly divisible by the number four, and at which delegations
2 to national party conventions are to be chosen.

3 SEC. 2. Section 1000 of the Elections Code is amended to read:

4 1000. The established election dates in each year are as follows:

5 (a) The second Tuesday of April in each even-numbered year.

6 (b) The first Tuesday after the first Monday in March of each
7 odd-numbered year.

8 (c) The first Tuesday after the first Monday in June in each year.

9 (d) The first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of
10 each year.

11 SEC. 3. Section 1001 of the Elections Code is amended to read:

12 1001. Elections held in June and November of each
13 even-numbered year are statewide elections and ~~these dates~~ *the*
14 *dates of those elections* are statewide election dates.

15 SEC. 4. Section 1202 of the Elections Code is amended to read:

16 1202. The presidential primary shall be held on the first
17 Tuesday after the first Monday in June in any year that is evenly
18 divisible by the number four, and shall be consolidated with the
19 statewide direct primary held in that year.
