An act to amend Section 2727.5 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to nursing.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1905, as introduced, Logue. Nursing.

Existing law, the Nursing Practice Act, prohibits a person from engaging in the practice of nursing without holding a license which is in an active status issued by the Board of Registered Nursing.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to these provisions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 2727.5 of the Business and Professions
- 2 Code is amended to read:
- 3 2727.5. A person licensed under this chapter who in good faith
- 4 renders emergency care at the scene of an emergency ~~which~~ *that*
- 5 occurs outside both the place and the course of that person's
- 6 employment shall not be liable for any civil damages as the result
- 7 of acts or omissions by that person in rendering the emergency
- 8 care.

- 1 This section shall not grant immunity from civil damages when
- 2 the person is grossly negligent.
