

**Introduced by Senator Dutton**

An act to repeal and add Section 14672.95 of the Government Code, relating to state hospitals.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1217, as introduced, Dutton. State hospitals: Patton State Hospital. Existing law authorizes the Department of General Services to perform various duties relating to state real property, including leasing a building located at Patton State Hospital to a private nonprofit corporation or local government, for a period not to exceed 20 years, for the purpose of providing services to elderly persons.

This bill would reauthorize the department to lease the specified premises, as described above.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 14672.95 of the Government Code is
