An act to amend Section 13001 of the Elections Code, relating to elections.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2407, as introduced, Morrell. Elections: expenses.

Existing law provides that expenses authorized and necessarily incurred in the preparation for and conduct of elections are to be paid from the county treasuries, except as specified.

This bill would make technical nonsubstantive changes to this provision of law.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13001 of the Elections Code is amended
2 to read:
3 13001. ~~Any~~ Any expenses authorized and necessarily incurred
4 in the preparation for, and conduct of, elections as provided in this
5 code shall be paid from the county treasuries, except that when an
6 election is called by the governing body of a city the expenses
7 shall be paid from the treasury of the city. ~~Any~~ Any payments shall
8 be made in the same manner as other county or city expenditures
9 are made. ~~The elections official~~ *Elections officials*, in providing

- 1 the materials required by this division, need not utilize the services
- 2 of the county or city purchasing agent.
