An act to add Sections 89528.5 and 92612.5 to the Education Code, relating to postsecondary education employees.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 495, as amended, Yee. Postsecondary education employees: physicians.

Existing law establishes the California State University and the University of California as 2 of the segments of public postsecondary education in this state. Existing law requires the Trustees of the California State University to establish a supplemental salary program in order to improve the recruitment and retention of faculty in specified academic disciplines, and requires the University of California to administer the Community-Based Health Professions Education Partnership Program.

This bill would-encourage make legislative findings and declarations that the California State University and the University of California-to should make the funding of student health center clinics a priority when allocating funds for student and campus services, and-to should give consideration for additional compensation to the physicians who address student health care challenges at student health-centers in the respective segments center clinics.
