An act to amend Section 27360 of the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles.

## LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 53, as introduced, Cristina Garcia. Vehicles: child safety seats. Existing law requires a parent, legal guardian, or the driver of a motor vehicle to properly secure a child under 8 years of age in an appropriate passenger restraint system while the child is riding in a motor vehicle.

This bill would require a parent, legal guardian, or the driver of a motor vehicle to properly secure a child under 2 years of age in an appropriate rear facing child safety seat while the child is riding in a motor vehicle.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

- SECTION 1. Section 27360 of the Vehicle Code is amended to read:
