An act to amend Section 1569.311 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to care facilities.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2794, as introduced, Santiago. Building standards: care facilities. Existing law requires every residential care facility for the elderly to have one or more carbon monoxide detectors in the facility, as provided.

This bill would make a nonsubstantive change to this provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1569.311 of the Health and Safety Code

4 have one or more carbon monoxide detectors in the facility that
5 meet the standards established in Chapter 8 (commencing with
6 Section 13260) of Part 2 of Division 12. The department shall
7 account for the presence of these detectors during inspections.

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
