Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 79—Relative to Trione Annadel State Park.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SCR 79, as amended, McGuire. Trione Annadel State Park.

This measure would request that the Department of Parks and Recreation rename Annadel State Park in the County of Sonoma as Trione Annadel State Park, *and*, *upon the receipt of donations from nonstate sources sufficient to cover the cost, install new signs reflecting the name change.*

Fiscal committee: yes.

- 1 WHEREAS, The Sonoma County Regional Parks Department
- 2 serves the social, cultural, and outdoor recreational needs of the
- 3 people of Sonoma County through the operation and maintenance
- 4 of 49 Regional Parks and Annadel State Park; and
- 5 WHEREAS, In 1972, Henry Trione was instrumental in the
- 6 creation of Annadel State Park by personally spending more than
- 7 \$1 million to preserve the 5,000-acre property from development;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, When the Department of Parks and Recreation
- 10 placed Annadel State Park on the park closure list in 2012, Henry
- 11 Trione made a substantial donation to help keep the park open

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1	under the operation of the Sonoma County Regional Parks
2	Department; and
$\frac{2}{3}$	WHEREAS, Henry Trione's support made it possible to keep
4	Annadel State Park open and accessible to the public on an ongoing
5	basis; and
6	WHEREAS, Henry Trione also offered a substantial contribution
7	that created Trione Fields at Tom Schopflin Park, which provides
8	an outstanding location for children in the community to play
9	soccer and softball; and
10	WHEREAS, The Sonoma County Board of Supervisors
11	recognized Henry Trione for his exceptional contributions to
12	Annadel State Park and other local parks and bestowed upon him
13	the title of "Honorary Regional Parks Ranger;" and
14	WHEREAS, In 2012, the State Park and Recreation Commission
15	voted to rename Eastshore State Park, an 8.5-mile stretch of the
16	East Bay shoreline, as McLaughlin Eastshore State Park in honor
17	of Berkeley environmentalist Sylvia McLaughlin; and
18	WHEREAS, The County of Sonoma and the City of Santa Rosa
19	are supportive of renaming Annadel State Park to recognize Henry
20	Trione and his achievements while retaining Annadel in the park's
21	name; now, therefore, be it
22	Resolved by the Senate of the State of California, the Assembly
23	thereof concurring, That the Legislature requests that the
24	Department of Parks and Recreation rename Annadel State Park
25	as Trione Annadel State Park; and be it further
26	WHEREAS, Annadel State Park, located in the historic Valley
27	of the Moon, an area popularized by author Jack London, became
28	a state park in 1971, and includes over 5,000 acres of rolling hills,
29	seasonal streams, meadows, trails, and woodlands, all located
30	near a major metropolitan area in Sonoma County; and
31	WHEREAS, The Sonoma County Regional Parks department
32	serves the social, cultural, and outdoor recreation needs of the
33	people of Sonoma County through the operation and maintenance
34	of 49 regional parks and has assisted the state in serving the park
35	needs of citizens statewide with the operation and maintenance of
36	Annadel State Park; and
37	WHEREAS, Annadel State Park in Sonoma County, originally
38	named the Annadel Ranch State Park, is one of the most widely

39 used parks in the state parks system; and

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1 WHEREAS, Henry Trione was a long-term resident of Sonoma

2 County before his death at the age of 94 years and was a true

3 "Renaissance Californian" who created a legacy across Sonoma

4 County and the entire north coast region; and

5 WHEREAS, Henry Trione's most significant and enduring 6 contribution to Sonoma County and the state of California is widely

7 acknowledged to be the creation of Annadel State Park in a wooded

7 acknowledged to be the creation of Annadel State Park in a wooded
8 wilderness area overlooking the Santa Rosa plain that was slated

9 for residential development; and

10 WHEREAS, It is widely recognized that Annadel State Park

11 would not exist today were it not for the personal tenacity of Henry

12 Trione and his initial personal contribution of \$1 million to

13 preserve the 5,000-acre property; and

14 WHEREAS, Henry Trione's actions to create Annadel State

15 Park are remarkable because they occurred long before the 16 importance of such public spaces closely linked to urban

17 development was widely understood; and

18 WHEREAS, In 2012 the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors 19 recognized Henry Trione for his exceptional contributions to

20 Annadel State Park and other local parks and bestowed upon him

21 the title of "Honorary Regional Parks Ranger"; and

22 WHEREAS, The Sonoma County Board of Supervisors and the

23 Santa Rosa City Council have each voted unanimously to urge the

24 State of California to similarly recognize Henry Trione and his

25 achievements with respect to Annadel State Park, while retaining

26 Annadel in the park's name; now, therefore, be it

27 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF

28 CALIFORNIA, THE ASSEMBLY THEREOF CONCURRING,

29 That the Legislature requests that the Department of Parks and

30 Recreation rename Annadel State Park as Trione Annadel State

31 Park and, upon receipt of donations from nonstate sources

32 sufficient to cover the cost, install new signs reflecting the name

33 *change; and be it further*
