An act to amend Section 93010 of the Government Code, relating to railroads.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 93, as introduced, Hauser. North Coast Railroad Authority.

Under existing law, the North Coast Railroad Authority is created in the Counties of Humboldt and Mendocino to provide railroad passenger and freight service.

This bill would add the Counties of Sonoma and Trinity to the authority.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 93010 of the Government Code
2 is amended to read:

3 93010. (a) The authority is hereby created ~~within the~~
4 ~~Counties of Humboldt and Mendocino~~, *having a service*
5 *area comprised of the Counties of Humboldt, Mendocino,*
6 *Sonoma, and Trinity*, to provide rail passenger and freight
7 service within those counties.

8 (b) The County of Marin ~~or the County of Sonoma, or~~
9 ~~both~~, may elect to join the authority and, if that election



1 is made, the authority is expanded to include ~~the county~~
2 ~~or counties so electing~~ *that county*.
