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CHAPTER ____

An act to amend Section 5090.40 of the Public Resources Code, and to amend Section 38235 of the Vehicle Code, relating to parks and recreation.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 728, Setencich. Parks and recreation: off-highway motor vehicle recreation: fund.

(1) Existing law, the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Act of 1988, provides for the acquisition, operation, and funding of state off-highway vehicular recreation areas and trails, and specifies that the system of off-highway vehicular recreation areas and trails is established primarily to provide facilities and opportunities for the purpose of operating off-highway motor vehicles, as defined.

This bill would make technical and clarifying changes in those provisions.

(2) Existing law requires a fee of \$4 to be paid, in addition to other specified fees, at the time of issuance or renewal of identification of an off-highway motor vehicle subject to identification. Existing law requires the money from these additional fees to be transferred to the Off-Highway Vehicle Trust Fund.

This bill would require the additional fees to be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the Off-Highway License Fee Fund, created by the bill, instead of requiring the fees to be transferred to the Off-Highway Vehicle Trust Fund.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 5090.40 of the Public Resources Code is amended to read:

5090.40. (a) The system consists of areas and trails that are established primarily to provide facilities and recreational opportunities for the purposes of operating



off-highway motor vehicles, as defined in Section 38006 of the Vehicle Code.

(b) The system shall be developed and maintained to sustain long-term use and shall be managed in a manner that is consistent with this chapter.

SEC. 2. Section 38235 of the Vehicle Code is amended to read:

38235. All money collected by the department under Section 38230 shall be reported monthly to the State Controller and at the same time deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the Off-Highway License Fee Fund, which is hereby created.
