An act to add Section 24013.5 to the Business and Professions Code, relating to alcoholic beverages.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1042, as introduced, Alpert. Alcoholic beverages: licenses: denial.

Existing law prohibits a license from being issued for any premises for which an application for a license has been denied, for reasons pertaining to the premises, unless one year has elapsed from the date the order becomes final.

This bill would prohibit an application for a license from being made more than once every 2 calendar years for any premises with respect to which an application for a license has been previously denied, for reasons pertaining to the premises, 3 times within 3 consecutive calendar years.

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 24013.5 is added to the Business
- 2 and Professions Code, to read:
- 3 24013.5. No application for a license shall be made
- 4 more than once every two calendar years for any
- 5 premises with respect to which an application for a

1 license has been previously denied, for reasons pertaining  
2 to the premises, three times within three consecutive  
3 calendar years.
