An act to add Section 24013.5 to the Business and Professions Code, relating to alcoholic beverages.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1042, as amended, Alpert. Alcoholic beverages: licenses: denial.

Existing law prohibits a license from being issued for any premises for which an application for a license has been denied, or at which a license has been revoked, for reasons pertaining to the premises, unless one year has elapsed from the date the order becomes final.

This bill would also prohibit a license from being issued for any premises for which a license has been denied ~~or revoked~~, for reasons pertaining to the premises, twice within a 36-month period, unless 2 years have elapsed from the date that the last order becomes final.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 24013.5 is added to the Business
2 and Professions Code, to read:

3 24013.5. (a) No license shall be issued for any
4 premises for which a license has been denied or revoked,
5 for reasons pertaining to the premises, unless one year has
6 elapsed from the date the order becomes final.

7 (b) No license shall be issued for any premises for
8 which a license has been denied ~~or revoked~~, for reasons
9 pertaining to the premises, twice within a 36-month
10 period, unless two years have elapsed from the date that
11 the last order becomes final.
