CHAPTER ____

An act relating to vehicles.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 49, Lockyer. Vehicles.

Existing law prohibits certain false and fraudulent acts in connection with insurance claims.

This bill would set forth findings and declarations relative to the need for reforms to prevent insurance fraud, make vehicle insurance coverage more affordable, reduce vehicle accident claim litigation, and enhance vehicle safety.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The Legislature finds and declares that reforms need to be enacted to prevent insurance fraud, enhance vehicle safety, make it more affordable for all Californians to purchase required vehicle insurance coverage, and reduce the number of litigated vehicle accident claims.
