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An act to amend Section ~~66418~~ 24011 of the Government Code, relating to ~~land-use~~ county government.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 766, as amended, Wiggins. ~~Subdivisions: design~~ Solano County.

*Existing law authorizes the boards of supervisors of specified counties to provide, by ordinance, that the public administrator be appointed by the board, and authorizes specified counties to appoint the same person to the offices of public administrator, veteran service officer, and public guardian.*

*This bill would include Solano County within those counties whose board of supervisors would be authorized to provide for the appointment of the public administrator by the board. It would also authorize the Board of Supervisors of Solano County to appoint the same person to the offices of public administrator and public guardian.*

~~Existing law, the Subdivision Map Act, authorizes local legislative bodies to regulate, by ordinance, the design and improvement of subdivisions for which a tentative and final map or parcel map is required. The act also defines "design"~~

~~to include such other specific physical requirements in the plan and configuration of the entire subdivision as may be necessary to ensure consistency with, or implementation of, the general plan or any applicable specific plan.~~

~~This bill would revise this definition to include a reference to the requirement that the design and improvement of the subdivision be consistent with the general plan or any specific plan.~~

7 (a) The boards of supervisors of Madera County,  
8 Mendocino County, *Solano County*, Trinity County, and  
9 Lake County may, by ordinance, provide that the public  
10 administrator shall be appointed by the board.

11 (b) The boards of supervisors of Madera County,  
12 Mendocino County, Trinity County, and Lake County  
13 may appoint the same person to the offices of public  
14 administrator, veteran service officer, and public  
15 guardian. *The Board of Supervisors of Solano County*  
16 *may, by ordinance, appoint the same person to the offices*  
17 *of public administrator and public guardian.*

18 (c) The boards of supervisors of Madera County,  
19 Mendocino County, Trinity County, and Lake County  
20 may separate the consolidated offices of district attorney  
21 and public administrator at any time in order to make the  
22 appointments permitted by this section. Upon approval  
23 by the board of supervisors, the officer elected to these  
24 offices at any time may resign, or decline to qualify for,  
25 the office of public administrator without resigning from,  
26 or declining to qualify for, the office of district attorney.

3 and widths; (2) drainage and sanitary facilities and  
4 utilities, including alignments and grades thereof; (3)  
5 location and size of all required easements and  
6 rights of way; (4) fire roads and firebreaks; (5) lot size  
7 and configuration; (6) traffic access; (7) grading; (8) land  
8 to be dedicated for park or recreational purposes; and (9)  
9 other specific physical requirements in the plan and  
10 configuration of the entire subdivision necessary to  
11 ensure consistency with, or implementation of, the  
12 general plan or any applicable specific plan as required  
13 pursuant to Section 66473.5.

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
