An act to add Section 330.5 to the Public Utilities Code, relating to public utilities.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 995, as amended, R. Wright. Electric restructuring: transmission grid.

The Public Utilities Act provides for the restructuring of the electrical industry in this state, including provisions with regard to the reliability and operation of the transmission grid.

This bill would state that it is the policy of this state that, to ensure the continued efficient use and reliable operation of the transmission grid and of any upgrades, enhancements, or additions to the transmission grid, transmission planning, siting, and permitting be conducted in a manner consistent with specified existing law, and that publicly owned utility transmission owners and investor-owned utility transmission owners continue to plan, design, and construct transmission provide nondiscriminatory, **facilities** SO to open, as comparable access to transmission services.

The bill would require the Independent System Operator to coordinate with *participating utility* transmission owners to implement those policies, consistent with specified provisions a specified provision of existing law.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:
