LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1082, as introduced, Calderon. Public Utilities Commission: natural gas restructuring.

The Public Utilities Act authorizes the Public Utilities Commission to investigate the restructuring of natural gas services, as specified, but prohibits the commission, prior to January 1, 2000, from enacting any gas industry restructuring decisions and from enforcing certain natural gas restructuring decisions for core customers.

This bill would extend that prohibition against enacting gas industry restructuring decisions until July 1, 2001.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

1 restructuring for core customers, as considered in 2 Rulemaking 98-01-011, including, but not limited to, 3 opening or changing competitive markets, establishing 4 consumer protection standards, or unbundling costs, 5 rates or services, is in the public interest, the commission 6 shall submit its findings and recommendations to the 7 Legislature. Prior to January 1, 2000 July 1, 2001, the 8 commission shall not enact any such gas industry 9 restructuring decisions.
