LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1149, as amended, Aroner. Underground electric and telephone communications facilities.

Under existing law, the Public Utilities Commission has regulatory authority over public utilities and, under that authority, has adopted a tariff tariffs for the replacement of overhead electric and communications facilities with underground facilities.

This bill would require the commission to conduct a study as to the ways to amend and improve the tariff those tariffs, as specified. The commission would be required to submit a report on the study to the Legislature on or before January 1, 2001.
