LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2076, as introduced, Shelley. State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission: fuel supply.

Existing law requires the State Energy Resources and Conservation and Development Commission to develop contingency plans to deal with possible shortages of electrical energy or fuel supplies to protect public health, safety, and welfare.

This bill would require the commission, after determining certain facts concerning an appropriate level of reserves, to establish and administer a strategic fuel reserve.

25720. In order to insulate California consumers and businesses from dramatic price increases arising from supply interruptions, it is the intent of the Legislature to establish a strategic fuel reserve to be administered by the commission.

25721. The commission shall determine appropriate level of reserves of fuels or fuel components 10 to insulate California consumers and businesses from 11 substantial. short-term price increases arising 12 refinery outages or other similar supply interruptions. In 13 making this determination, the commission shall take into 14 account all of the following:

- (a) Inventories of California-quality fuels fuel or 16 components reasonably available the California market.
 - (b) Current and historic levels of inventory of fuels.
 - (c) The availability and cost of storage of fuels.
 - potential for future supply interruptions, price spikes, and the costs thereof to California consumers and businesses.
- 25722. (a) Not later than July 1, 2002, the commission 24 shall establish the California Strategic Fuel Reserve.
- (b) The commission shall establish, by regulation, a 26 triggering mechanism for the release, by order of the Governor, of fuel or fuel components from the strategic market reserve to the California reduce substantial, short-term price increases.
- (c) In releasing fuel or fuel components from the 31 strategic fuel reserve, the commission 32 preference to firms that will use those products to reduce prices to California consumers and businesses.
