An act to add Chapter 7.5 (commencing with Section 25650) to Division 15 of the Public Resources Code, relating to energy assistance.

## LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2705, as amended, Committee on Agriculture. Agricultural industry energy program.

Under existing law, there is a loan program to assist low-income fishing fleet operators reduce their energy costs and conserve fuel by providing low-interest loans to those operators. Prior acts have also appropriated federal oil overcharge funds in the Petroleum Violation Escrow Account to the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission for a farm energy assistance program.

This bill would require the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission to establish an agricultural industry energy program to provide loans for the purchase of equipment and services for agriculture energy efficiency and development demonstration projects. The bill would provide that the loans have a repayment period of not

more than 7 years, and bear interest at a rate not less than 2% below the rate earned by moneys in the Pooled Money Investment Account. Funds funds from loan repayments and interest would on loans made by the commission pursuant to an agriculture energy assistance program to be required to be deposited **Technologies** in the Energy Research, Development, Account. and Demonstration and upon appropriation, would to be available for loans and technical assistance. The bill would provide that the loans have a repayment period of not more than 7 years, and bear interest at a rate not less than 2% below the rate earned by moneys in the Pooled Money Investment Account.

- (c) The loans shall contain terms providing for a 8 repayment period of not more than seven years and for interest at a rate that is not less than 2 percent below the 10 rate earned by moneys in the Pooled Money Investment Account.
