LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2705, as amended, Committee on Agriculture. Agricultural industry energy program.

Under existing law, there is a loan program to assist low-income fishing fleet operators reduce their energy costs and conserve fuel by providing low-interest loans to those Prior acts have also appropriated federal overcharge funds in the Petroleum Violation Escrow Account Resources the State Energy Conservation and Development Commission for a farm energy assistance program.

This bill would require funds from loan repayments and interest on loans made by the commission pursuant to an

agriculture energy assistance program to be deposited in the Energy Technologies Research, Development, and Demonstration appropriation, to Account, and upon be available for loans and technical assistance. The bill would provide that the loans have a repayment period of not more than 7 years, and bear interest at a rate not less than 2% below the rate earned by moneys in the Pooled Money Investment

Existing law establishes a state program managed by the Department of Food and Agriculture and the commission to assist in the development of solar technology in agriculture.

This bill would repeal that provision.
