An act to amend Section 1258.220 of the Code of Civil Procedure, relating to eminent domain.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 634, as introduced, Kelley. Eminent domain.

Existing law specifies the time period within which various documents must be exchanged in eminent domain proceedings absent an agreement thereto.

This bill would revise that time period, as specified.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1258.220 of the Code of Civil  
 2 Procedure is amended to read:  
 3 1258.220. For the purposes of this article, the "date of  
 4 exchange" is the date agreed to for the exchange of their  
 5 lists of expert witnesses and statements of valuation data  
 6 by the party who served a demand and the party on  
 7 whom the demand was served or, failing such agreement,  
 8 a date—40 90 days prior to commencement of the trial on  
 9 the issue of compensation or the date set by the court on  
 10 noticed motion of either party establishing good cause  
 11 therefor.

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
