LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 669, as introduced, Polanco. Local emergency telephone systems.

Existing law, the Warren-911-Emergency Assistance Act, directs the Communications Division of the Department of General Services to consult regularly with specified agencies, officials, and entities to accomplish its responsibilities with respect to the establishment by local agencies of 911 telephone service.

This bill would direct the Communications Division also to consult for that purpose with a local representative from a city and a county.
