An act to amend Section 373 of the Public Utilities Code, relating to public utilities.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1095, as introduced, Bowen. Electrical restructuring.

Existing law governing electrical restructuring authorizes electrical corporations to apply to the Public Utilities Commission for an order determining that certain uneconomic costs not be collected from a particular class of customer or category of electricity consumption, as prescribed.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes in that provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 373 of the Public Utilities Code
2 is amended to read:

3 373. (a) Electrical corporations may apply to the
4 commission for an order determining that the costs
5 identified in Sections 367, 368, 375, and 376 not be
6 collected from a particular class of customer or category
7 of electricity consumption.

8 (b) Subject to the fire wall specified in subdivision (e)
9 of Section 367, ~~the provisions of~~ this section and Sections



1 372 and 374 shall apply ~~in the event~~ *if* the commission
2 authorizes a nonbypassable charge prior to the
3 implementation of an Independent System Operator and
4 Power Exchange referred to in subdivision (a) of Section
5 365.
