## LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1095, as introduced, Bowen. Electrical restructuring.

Existing law governing electrical restructuring authorizes electrical corporations apply to the Public Utilities to order Commission for determining that certain an uneconomic costs not be collected from a particular class of electricity category of consumption, customer or prescribed.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes in that provision.
